<u>TOPIC</u> – Release benchmarking and other documents (1995-1999) useful for members to evaluate the economic efficiency of Chugach Electric.

DISCUSSION (by Director Kreig)

Chugach participated in a series of benchmarking projects from 1995 to 1998. The intent was to see how Chugach Electric compared to the best practices of other utility companies. The intended benefit was to judge whether our costs in certain areas are reasonable or deserve a closer look. The benchmarking reports were issued and presented to management and the board prior to 1998 and they have never been released to the member-ratepayers.

As far back as March 1997, the Outlet stated that "we intend to begin reporting measures that will improve our accountability to the membership and help you be an informed voter in coop elections." Therefore, it is long overdue that these key studies (which cost member-ratepayers approximately \$0.5 million) be released in order to increase transparency and public reporting.

For the same reasons other documents presented during two board retreats (1998 - 1999) on increasing competitiveness in the Alaska electric utility industry also should be released.

Manner of release
